**+ REMEMBERING OUR VETERANS +**

Veterans Day is November 11th. It is the official USA holiday honoring individuals who have or are serving in U.S. Armed Forces. This federal holiday came about to mark the end of major hostilities of WWI that ended at the 11th hour of the 11th day in Nov. 1918. St. Vitus Parishioners have faithfully served in WWI, WWII, Korea, Vietnam and the Gulf Wars. In the parish courtyard is a “Memorial Monument” that commemorates the high cost of freedom, listing the names of the 43 parishioners who gave their lives in defense of the many freedoms we have in the United States of America. Please keep our fallen and living Veterans in your prayers.

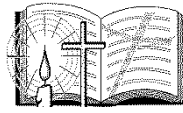

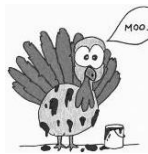
