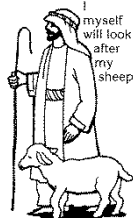

**+ REMEMBERING OUR VETERANS +**

**This Sunday is Veterans Day.** It is the official USA holiday honoring individuals who served or are serving in U.S. Armed Forces. This federal holiday came about to mark the end of major hostilities of WWI that ended at the 11th hour of 11th day in November 1918. Over 1,000 St. Vitus Parishioners have faithfully served in WWI, WWII, Korea, Vietnam and the Gulf Wars. In the parish courtyard is a **“Memorial Monument”** that commemorates the high cost of freedom, listing the names of the 43 parishioners who gave their lives in defense of the many freedoms we have in the United States of America. Please keep our fallen and living Veterans in your prayers.

**WORD OF GOD FOR THIS SUNDAY** – An extra-

ordinary gospel scene: Jesus and his apostles watching the faithful making donations to the temple treasury. This must have been a daily spectacle with hundreds of years of tradition behind it. Evidently, donations to the treasury were as different as the people making them, because every believing Jew, rich or poor, was obliged to give donations for the support of the temple. Some donations were made with great fanfare while others went nearly unnoticed, like the poor widow’s gift. Jesus observed “the unnoticed” widow and commented that she gave everything she had. She didn’t hold back, but trusted that God would care for her needs. We probably know people like the poor widow and are humbled by it.

**CONGRATULATIONS TO NATHAN DOLINAR!** - St. Vitus Parish was informed by St. Ignatius High School that our parishioner, Nathan Milan Dolinar, was named a "**National Merit Commended Scholar.**" In the USA over 1.6 million students take a preliminary SAT qualifying test each year. Of the 1.6 million students, only 50,000 are named as either National Merit Scholars or Commended Scholars in the Scholarship competition and advance to Finalist standing by meeting a number of additional requirements.

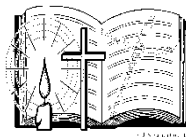

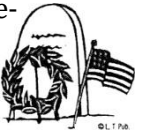
