FIRST MASS OF THANKSGIVING – Andrew Rudmann will have a First Mass of Thanksgiving at St. Vitus Church on Sun., June 9th, at a 10:00 a.m. All Parish Mass. Mr. Rudmann will be ordained a Roman Catholic priest on June 1, 2019, in Archdiocese of New Orleans. The 11:00 a.m. Mass for his ordination will be live streamed on the Archdiocese of New Orleans website, nolacatholic.org.

Andrew is the eldest of seven children. He graduated, from St. Ignatius H. S. and Franciscan University of Steubenville, OH, with a bachelor's degree in business. He was two years out of college with a job and an acceptance letter to attend Duquesne University's Pharmacy School when he responded to a call to become a priest in the Roman Catholic Church. He enrolled in Notre Dame Seminary in New Orleans (LA) in 2013 and will be ordained June 1st, 2019.


A social gathering and opportunity to meet Rev. Rudmann in St. Vitus Parish Auditorium will occur after the Mass. Rev. Rudmann will then return to serve in the archdiocese of New Orleans.
